We feel fortunate to have Vision Development so close to our home

At the age of 5, our daughter Laurian began showing struggles with reversals and reading. This resulted in a lack of confidence as the Kindergarten year passed. With recommendations to possibly repeat the grade at the end of the year, we began to search for possible solutions to correct her reversals in her school work. Laurian did not have any issues socially or in her everyday activities, but there was a stumbling block when it came to reading at school. After researching reversals and talking with teachers, Dr. Bauernfiend was recommended.

Laurian began therapy twice a week at the end of the Kindergarten year. We were leary of the young age, but school work demanded a solution. Laurian was very consistent in her practice. Some activities were more challenging than others, but it was obvious that all the visual exercises were strengthening her tracking ability. We began to see confidence at school, spontaneous reading and better grades overall. She still has some reversals but they are fewer and farther between after completion of the program. She is also aware of her own mistakes and has begun to self-correct.

Laurian is well into her 1st grade year. While it takes much focus, she is doing much better with reading fluency. She enjoys reading and does not shy from the challenge. We are thankful for the Vision Development Center's dedication to helping each individual. We feel fortunate to have this type of therapy so close to our home.
